Greetings, Christ Evangelical Lutheran Church!
As we approach the beginning of July, I remember the July Fourth holiday when we celebrate our nation's freedoms as well as our independence from foreign powers. Depending upon the region, we cook various barbecue styles, and we fix various sides. We have parades, speeches, and fireworks. People experience an upswell in the spirit of patriotism as we remember a significant moment of our nation's history.

At the core of our civil liberties lies a critical question, "What do we do with these liberties?" How do we live into our freedoms? Do we still consider them freedoms, or have we allowed them to devolve into entitlements? Do we celebrate freedom of speech against the government, or do we metamorphosize that freedom into saying anything one wants regardless of who one hurts?

Part of the Christian walk of discipleship is to keep wrestling with what we do with the freedoms God has given us as Christians. (Especially for us, as Christians living in America.) We are freed from the wages of our sin through the grace of God expressed most fully by Jesus' death on the cross. Kennedy once challenged a generation of people, "Ask not what your country can do for you, but what you can do for your country," so too does God challenge all of us to be like Christ who came to serve others, not to be served. Thank you to all who have supported the ministry of Christ Lutheran with your gifts as well as your talents. Giving through May has been strong. Please don't forget that the church expenses continue during the summer when many are away and attendance is often lower.
I recently saw an article that said the post office is not recommending that we mail checks because of many thefts. We have installed a locking mailbox to help ensure that any checks sent to the church are as safe as possible. After we had a check stolen last year and the ensuing forgeries, I have made every effort to pay the church bills with electronic transfers or a credit card whenever possible. I only mail checks inside of the post office.

For those of you who use checks and cannot always bring them to church, there are several other options. We still offer Simply Giving although the name has changed to Vanco Solutions. That does involve a very small charge that the church pays. Bill Pay through your bank is free to both you and the church. We have not yet investigated online giving but if there is enough interest from members, we can do that. I know many congregations offer that. Please let me know if you would be interested in online giving.
